<p>What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort use a range of strokes effectively (for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke)?</p>	<p>69%</p>
<p>What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort completed their personal survival qualifications?</p>	<p>All except 2 were able to float and all were able to tread water. All were confident to jump into the pool.</p>
