

How to make a Tudor seal!

1. Gather together your resources, and ensure your crayon has no paper around it. The crayon can be any colour, but red is best for realism.
2. Heat up your crayon and drip this onto the envelope where it folds over to seal. This should end up about the size of your coin/button or just a bit bigger.
3. Blow on the wax gently to spread it over the corner of the fold and to help it cool.
4. Wait for a few seconds and then press your coin/ button into the wax. Leave it there until the wax has completely cooled.
5. Carefully remove your coin/ button.
