Meeting national curriculum requirements for swimming and water safety	Please complete all of the below*:
What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres?	The 2019/2020 Year 6 cohort 51 children accessed swimming sessions. 69% were able to swim 25 metres or more.
What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke]?	Year 6 cohort 2019/2020 have attended swimming. 58% of them are able to swim 25 meters or more using more than one stroke.
What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort completed their personal survival qualifications?	All except 5 were able to float and to tread water. All except 1 was confident to jump into the pool . 88%
