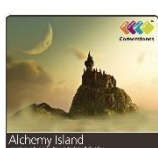




Year 5 End of Year Newsletter

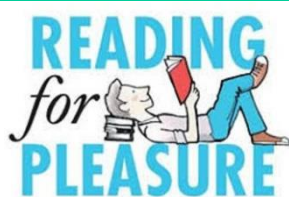
