## Have a wonderful safe summer!

In Term Six we had a visit from the RNLI to talk to us about being safe on the beach. Remember to swim somewhere safe and always with a grown up. Look for the red and yellow flags to swim safely when the life guards are there. We talked about inflatables on the sea. Try not to take them to the beach, if you have one make sure that a grown up has a string attached to the inflatable and then tied securely to the grown up. We saw a teddy with the rope tied to his arm to remind us of this.

We talked about things you need at the beach, such as sun cream, shade, water and a phone. If you see someone in trouble a grown up will call 999. Look for the information signs on the beach so that you can tell the coastquard where you are.

We also talked about not playing near cliffs.


We loved the teddy bears who showed us how to be safe.
